The Creative Role of the Composer

In association with the Australian Film Television and Radio School's Year of The Composer, the MFF presents a live music event at the State Film Theatre, conducted by Sydney based composer, Art Phillips.

Art's credits include Sher Mountain Killing Mystery (AFI nomination), Santa Barbara and The Fatal Bond. He has worked as an orchestrator, producer, composer, musical director, and has recently received two Grammy Awards and a Penguin Award. He has taught at the Grove School of Music (USA), the AFI, as well as the ABC School of Music.

This seminar will focus on the composer's creative role in scoring music for film and television. Using a high-tech set up of synthesisers, samplers and computers, Art will demonstrate his musical ideas LIVE-TO-PICTURE. He'll discuss musical timings, textures, the impact of recent technology and the emotional interplay between sound and image. You will see and hear how different pieces of music can completely alter the meaning of a scene.
